MKCsBK Newsletter #2, April 2008

The big event of the year was our conference held in Venice, Florida on February 23rd. By all standards, it was a success with over thirty attending. I am enclosing a detailed account of the conference for all those who could only be there with us in spirit. I wish to thank again all those who gave of their time and effort to help make the conference a success.

I was, at last, successful in determining that the MKCsBK had been placed under the tax-exempt umbrella of the Ohio based American Hungarian Friendship and International Care Association. This means that all donations to the MKCsBK are tax-exempt, as is noted on our receipts. Because we do not have an MKCsBK bank account, all donations need to be made out in my name with an MKCsBK designation on the check. I am keeping a record of all donations and expenses and can give an account as needed.

If anyone should become aware of a csendőr or csendőr family having financial problems, please notify me, so that we may be able to help as our finances allow.

I am pleased to announce that we now have a csendőr decal, pictured here, available for purchase. The decals are 3 x 4 inches. They may be placed on car windows, suitable for framing, or attached to any other surface. Their cost is \$2 (US) apiece, plus postage. You can write me or send me an email if you wish to purchase one or more. I am also considering making available T-shirts with a csendőr picture over the heart on the left side. These would probably cost between \$10 to \$15 dollars apiece, plus postage. Please, let me know if there is an interest in these shirts before I invest in such an order. Our goal in all of this is to keep the csendőrség before the public and thus make people more aware of them.


The web site was visited on more than 670 occasions in the month of March with over 10,250 visits in the past two years.
